I hope you find this dialogue helpful to simplify your communications of the gospel.

“Are you good enough to get into Heaven”

Here are examples of TS* (transitional statements) to use - what to say:

1) We are all going to die – “When You Die ...

You say: “What do you think happens after someone dies?
or Do you think there is an afterlife?”

You say: “If you die today – God says, “Why should I let you into heaven?”

Most people will answer: **Good enough**

They normally: “I have tried to be a Good Person” or “I hope I’ve been good enough.”

You say: “The greatest discovery I have ever made was -
“I am not good enough nor will I ever be good enough to get into heaven.”

Then you say: “Have you read the story of ‘Mr. Nice Guy’? (I was like him.)

“He thought he was so good he should get to the head of the Line.”

“ then he had to take the test that God uses to see how good you are.”

“ I know (feel) you would you would like to read his brief story.”

Give the track - “Are You a Good Person?”
